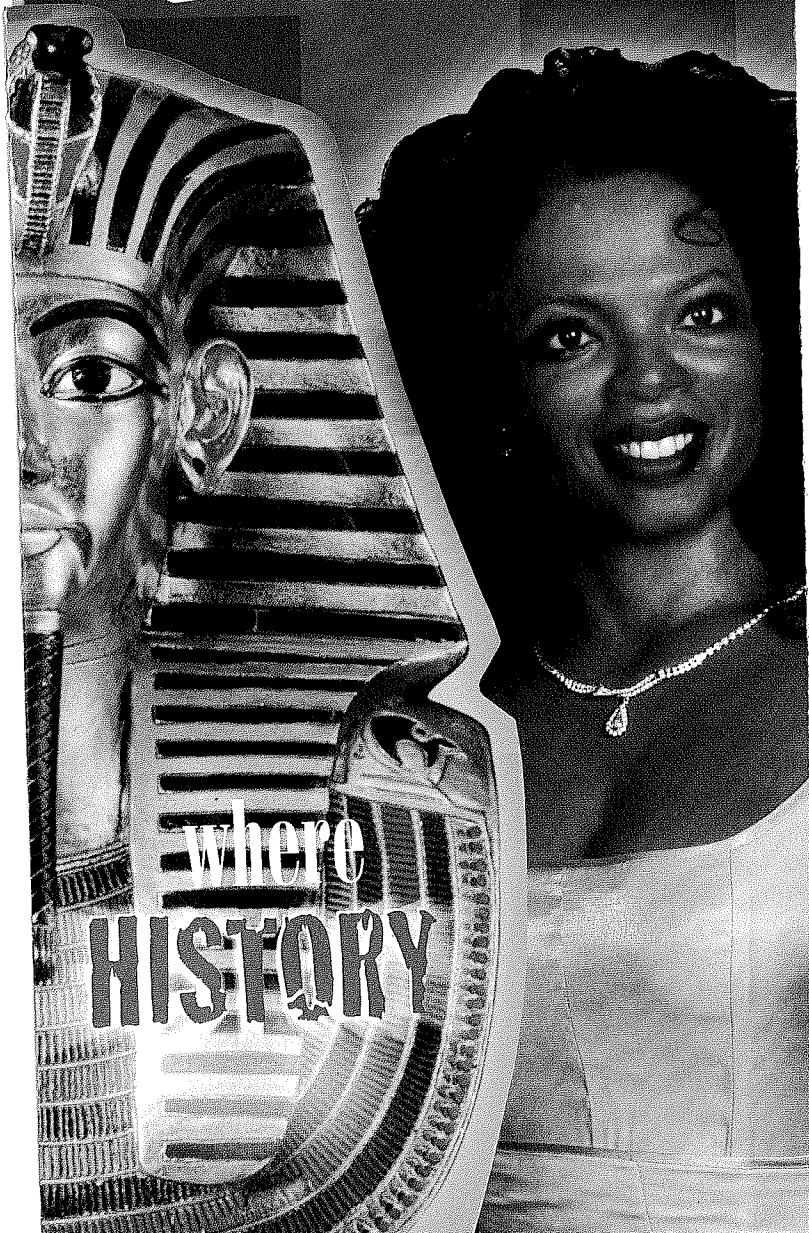

## ALL ROADS LEAD TO FISHERMAN'S WHARF

**CABLE CARS:** Board at Powell and Market Streets, or at any stop along the way. Disembark two blocks from Fisherman's Wharf.

**MUNI:** Board Muni's #15, #19, #30, #32, #42 or the antique "F" Line streetcars on Market Street and the Embarcadero.

**BART:** Disembark at the Civic Center, Powell St, Montgomery St, or Embarcadero Station. Connect with a Wharf-bound Muni car (listed above).

**BY CAR:** ORANGE SIGNS are posted throughout the city directing visitors to Fisherman's Wharf.

From Reno, Sacramento, The East Bay - I80 across Bay Bridge, take 1st San Francisco exit. Watch for ORANGE SIGNS.

From North Bay - Cross the Golden Gate Bridge to Marina Blvd, then to Lombard St. At Van Ness Avenue, turn left. Watch for ORANGE SIGNS.

From South Bay & Peninsula - I01 North to San Francisco, follow toward the Bay Bridge. Exit 4th or 7th Street (just before the bridge) Or 280 North, exit at King Street. Watch for ORANGE SIGNS.
